WHO ARE WE?

ASK helps families of children with special needs find resources and information to help their children.

WHAT DO WE DO?

Most families are given a diagnosis but receive little or no guidance on how to help their child.

We're like a navigational tool that knows where the resources are and the paths to get to them. We guide families along these paths.

We offer trainings to help caregivers access resources they need to help their child.

Families can find help to access healthcare options, financial assistance, educational support, respite, medical equipment, state and federal programs, support groups, and all other areas related to children with special needs... by calling ASK.

WHO DO WE HELP?

We help ALL Indiana kids with every kind of special need:

- Physical disabilities
- Chronic illness
- Mental health issues
- Learning disabilities

We help kids with special needs and their parents and siblings too. ASK provides family-centered care and addresses the needs of the entire family.

ASK is also used as a resource by educators and medical professionals who serve families of children with special needs.

FAMILIES WE'VE HELPED

When families call ASK for help, they speak with someone who knows what they're going through; an ASK parent liaison. Each of our parent liaisons have a child with special needs and are trained in all areas related to special needs.
